

ALEJANDRA SEEBER

Alejandra Seeber (Buenos Aires, 1969) offers a dialogic approach to painting, where intentionality and random procedures, failings and acceptance operate together without hierarchy. Seeber conceptualizes painting, not from historical references or social conventions but instead from a visual culture crossed by alternative rock, theatrical stage designs, musical shows, the city's underground, the digital software that started being used in graphic design and installations as a questioning of the observer's position. Casting her gaze on domestic interiors, architecture, ornamentation and the most trivial fragments, Seeber finds an image of the world that she rapidly blows up in stains and squirts that scatter through the canvas making it impossible to see the difference between inside and outside, between figures and abstraction. In this battle for domesticating symbols and updating meaning, Seeber ends up adding new forms and contexts to images resulting in multiple-layered works that invite us to renegotiate the boundaries between totality and fragment. She lives and works in New York.
