

JOAQUÍN BOZ

Joaquín Boz (Rojas, 1987) creates abstract paintings and drawings in different scales, working with the characteristics that matter provides from the body and gestures. In his works, intensity is placed upon the development of the work, and the materials change according to the medium. Each work presents a different story to appreciate, both in its entirety and in the details, where the different stages of his work are perceived. His paintings and drawings are the result of processes of loading the material that covers and discovers, reveals and conceals, weakens and strengthens. Every one of Boz's paintings brings to light the making of numerous discrete decisions and organic networks of hieroglyphic marks that register intimate and piercing conversations between the artist and the materials. He lives and works in Buenos Aires.
